

Competition on the route Kramfors – Arlanda

Vulkan Travel, a travel company headquartered in Umeå, Sweden, will start service between Kramfors and Arlanda.

The route will be operated with a Saab 340 aircraft from Avion Express, which currently operates the route Storuman - Arlanda. First flight will depart on Tuesday, September 15th.

- Vulkan Travel has seen the business opportunity to operate Kramfors - Arlanda as Storuman Airport admitted that the plane that operates on the route Storuman - Arlanda can stopover in Kramfors. This is possible due to that the current load factor of Storuman allows far more passengers, said Vulkan Travel owner Benedikt Kristinsson.
- He also says that with such collaboration between Vulkan Travel, Storuman Airport and Avion Express, there is a better opportunity to ensure the traffic entirety in the future.
- Vulkan Travel also sees the future service procurement for route Storuman - Arlanda as interesting, concludes Kristinsson.

The procurement, which is set to take place in autumn 2009, will cover the years 2010 - 2011. This contract will allow for a stopover on the way to the destination airport, so the possibilities in Kramfors will be available.
